On circular routes, the East Midlands Ring goes through contrasting scenery from Leicester to the River Soar. The Warwickshire Ring, for the more energetic, also has the contrasts with beautiful countryside around Warwick, then industry near Birmingham and Spaghetti Junction. Trips of beauty and interest can also be achieved, including Stratford-on-Avon, Oxford, Snarestone, or a visit to the Waterways Museum at Stoke Bruerne, depending on the number of locks which you wish to negotiate.
